1) FABRA OBSERVATORY

The Fabra observatory, located on the Tibidabo mountain, is a unique and emblematic place of the city where, since its inception, work has been carried out in three areas:

Astronomy, Meteorology and Seismology.

2) REQUESENS PALACE

The Requesens Palace in Barcelona is a monument cataloged as Cultural Asset of National Interest (BICN). Located in the neighborhood Gothic was the largest residential building that existed in the city in medieval times.

3) RAMC

6) OLD HOUSE OF CONVALESCENCE



The Royal Academy of Pharmacy of Catalonia is located in the dependencies of the old Santa Cruz Hospital in Barcelona, which, to a large extent, coincide with the space where the hospital's pharmacy was located.
